


About Me

Learning

At Home

Home Learning activities go home on alternate Mondays (even weeks) and the students have 2 weeks to complete the activities. There are always Reading, Spelling and Basic Facts components.

When Reading, students need to read for 30 minutes and fill in a reading log. Spelling requires students to learn a rule and practice spelling 10 words using the look/say/cover/write/check method for a test later in the week. For Maths, students will be practicing a skill on Mathletics (when it is set up) and completing a basic facts exercise.

The other activities usually have a theme or life-skill focus, and are designed to fit in with a busy schedule. Examples of these tasks may require students to help cook a family meal and describe what they did, or watch some of the news and explain one current event

At School

In Room 10, students will be working on Literacy and Maths for at least an hour each day.

Maths is generally taught from 9:30 to 10:30 each morning, with a later session on Fridays.

Literacy, comprised of Reading and Writing, will be taught in the "Literacy Block" from 10:50 to 12:30. Writing will also often be integrated into the Theme work.

Theme is taught in the afternoons. This term we are investigating how to be a good citizen... in our family, school, community, country and the world. This afternoon block is flexible, and we will integrate Science, Technology, Social Studies, Visual and Performing Arts into our Theme learning.
