Monday 8th October – Today is about creating a living art piece to take home and care for.

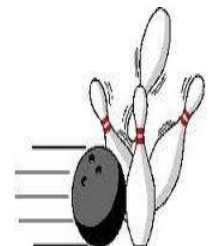
Tuesday 9th October – What amazing things can you find and do around the school? We will set a team challenge Scavenger Hunt for the day involving finding, making and creating things.
