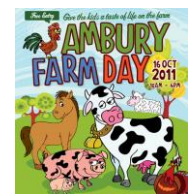
Wednesday 18th April – What child doesn't like making donuts? Enjoy baking with the OSCAR staff and coming up with your own quirky decorating of these donuts.
