### 08/ What happens if my child misses a session?

Because we ask parents to pay in advance for a term you will be charged if your child misses a session. Please let us know as soon as you can that your child will not be attending their scheduled session.

### 09/ Can I stay during the session?

After the first session we prefer that parents do not stay. Our programme is designed to keep you in touch with your child's learning, however. Via an online system we will share with you (and any significant others) what your child has achieved during their session and their progress to date.

## What our parents want to know

### 01/ Who is this for?

Reach caters to school-aged children from Year 1 through to Year 8 (Stages 1-7+, curriculum levels 1-5). Whether your child is falling behind their peers or needing extension, our main aim is to build skill and confidence in maths by having fun and working with your child's interests.

### 02/ What is the student-tutor ratio?

At Reach, each tutor works with a small group of children (no more than three) who are working at similar stages (3:1 ratio). In this way we are able to move at your child's pace and control the feedback that your child receives.

### 03/ What does it cost?

After your child's first, free session (which includes assessment), sessions cost \$50. We operate within primary school terms that are usually 10 weeks.

### 04/ What are the payment options?

These are the payment options available for parents:

1. Pay in full at the start of term via online banking
2. Pay in full at the start of term with credit card
3. Pay in three instalments (weeks 3, 6, & 9 of term) via online banking




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### 05/ Who will tutor my child?

Our tutors are all qualified teachers, or teacher trainees, with extensive and current knowledge of the New Zealand mathematics curriculum. Check out our About Us page to view some of our tutors and the directors of Reach Education.

### 06/ When and where are sessions held?

One-hour Reach sessions are available on weekday evenings between 4-7pm and Saturday mornings from 9am-12 noon. Sessions are held at Grey Lynn Community Centre and in Lynfield. If you would like us to operate in your suburb, please let us know via our Contact Us page.



### 07/ How often should my child attend tutoring?

At Reach we believe a regular and trusting tutor-student relationship is foremost, and for this reason we recommend your child attend once or twice per week, depending on their goals.
