5. Board of Trustees Uniform Procedure

Purpose

- To foster pride and self-esteem in the students of Kohia Terrace School
- To provide a sense of identity for the school in the community
- To provide clear guidelines of the Kohia Terrace School uniform dress code
- To reflect the wishes of the school community

Guidelines

- All students are required to follow the Kohia Terrace School uniform dress code.
- The Board of Trustees has the responsibility for setting the dress code, and for making changes as required.
- In making any changes to the code, the impact will be minimized as much as possible through the provision of an adequate phase in period. In setting the dress code, or making any changes to it, the Board of Trustees has regard for: equity, practicality, affordability, health and safety, quality and/or availability.
- Items that comprise the dress code will be reviewed as appropriate
- The Principal has the authority to sanction, in individual cases, variances to the dress code (for reasons of religious beliefs, physical impediment etc).
- The dress code will be strictly adhered to. Students who do not comply should be brought to the attention of the associate principal who will send a reminder letter.
- Frequent non-compliance will be brought to the attention of the Principal who may follow the School's discipline plan after dialogue with the parent(s).
- Students representing the school at a sporting event are required to wear the Kohia Terrace School sports uniform. Appropriate footwear for these events should also be worn.
- All items should be clearly named to ensure ease of identification. If embroidered, it must be in a thread that matches the fabric.
- A hat must be worn when students are outside during terms 1 and 4.
- The dress code will set out which items are compulsory, and which items are optional.

Kohia Terrace School Uniform Code

Compulsory

Kohia Terrace School polo (long or short sleeved) or t-shirt

Kohia Terrace School grey polo (intermediates only)

Kohia Terrace School pants, trousers, shorts, or skort

Kohia Terrace School sweatshirt or polar fleece

Shoes, trainers and sandals must be a single colour i.e. ALL black or dark blue or brown including the sole and laces. No crocs or jandals.

Other coloured trainers can be worn for PE but should not be worn to and from school

Socks navy or black, long or short, short white socks

Tights (navy or black) may also be worn

A hat (your choice) for terms 1 and 4

Kohia Terrace School PE shirt (intermediates only)

Optional

Dark blue or black polypropylene only

Kohia Terrace School beanie

Kohia Terrace sunhat or cap

Kohia Terrace School sports shirt (blue) orders through school

Kohia Terrace School house t-shirt orders through school

Kohia Terrace School vest orders through school

Kohia Terrace School jacket orders through school

All items of clothing **MUST** be named, particularly sweatshirts, polar fleeces, shoes, hats as these items are more likely to be taken on and off through a day.

Footwear includes lace up, Velcro, slip-ons and buckle shoes, sports shoes and sandals.

For the safety of students, no necklaces should be worn and earrings are restricted to studs only.
