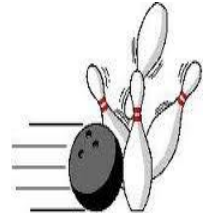


# JULY DAY SCHEDULE KOHIA KIDS OSCAR HOLIDAY PROGRAMME
